From one of the truly great houses, a full bodied yet creamy style.


## Dessert Wine

## White Wines

### France

1 **Domaine Vedilhan Viognier** 1 £20.95  
The style of this wine is dry, crisp and elegant, with fresh gooseberry fruit dominating the senses.

2 **Touraine Sauvignon Pre Baron** 2 £25.95  
A region in the Loire Valley that produces Sauvignon Blanc with all the aromatic and mineral qualities of much higher priced Sancerre's, but with a juicier style.

3 **Chablis A.C. Domaine de la Motte** 2 £29.95  
Typical of what a decent Chablis should taste like, not a trace of oak, pungent and flinty on the nose with a tad of creamy fruit beneath.

4 **Picpoul de Pinet** 3 £24.95  
If you like crisp, dry whites with vibrant acidity, then this is for you. Ideal fish and chicken wine but also a fantastic aperitif.

### Italy

5 **Mirabello Pinot Grigio** 1 £19.95  
175ml £5.35 250ml £6.95  
Ever popular, this Italian pinot is full of apple and pear fruit with a rounded, soft finish.

6 **Gavi La Batistina** 2 £26.50  
Italy is NOT just Pinot Grigio.  
Crisp and fruity with hints of mango and lime.

### Spain

7 **Rioja Blanco Manzanos** 1 £21.95  
Bright and vibrant with mouthwatering fruit flavours. Soft aromatics and lithe acidity make a great alternative to the myriad of Sauvignon Blanc.

### Australia

8 **The Gavel Chardonnay** 1 £17.95  
175ml £4.95 250ml £6.25  
Modern Chardonnay is rapidly gaining popularity, with juicy, tropical fruit and soft, creamy acidity & definitely NO oak.

### South Africa

9 **False Bay Chenin Blanc** 1 £21.95  
Probably the best Chenin we've tasted from South Africa. Bursting with red apple fruitiness and a lithe limey finish.

### Chile

10 **Los Pastos Sauvignon Blanc** 2 £18.95  
175ml £5.15 250ml £6.25  
Ripe apple and floral aromatics with typical sauvignon acidity.  
*It's definitely upsetting a few Kiwi's!*

### New Zealand

11 **Sauvignon Blanc Sileni Estate** 2 £25.50  
Marlborough on top form.  
Bright gooseberries, grassy and luscious mouthwatering acidity.

### Germany

13 **Niersteiner Gutes Domtal Q.b.a** 5 £19.95  
Juicy and floral with a hint of elder flower.  
A medium white in the classic Germanic style.

## Red Wines

### France

14 **La Madone Fleurie** B £27.95  
Ripe red fruit flavours with hints of strawberry and morello cherries. Full and firm grip on the finish.

15 **Chateau Bellevue Cotes de Bourg** C £26.95  
Bordeaux value at its best.  
Blackcurrant's, supple tannins, cigar boxes & cedar wood.

16 **Cotes du Rhone Villages Les Coteaux** B £23.95  
Quite simply a great Rhone red.  
Dark fruit, soft spice and a hint of herbal leafiness.

17 **Pinot Noir Le Fou** C £23.95  
A delicious Pinot from the Languedoc.  
Subtle, vegetal nose with cherry/raspberry fruit.

### Italy

18 **Araldica Barolo** E £31.95  
An Italian powerhouse. Brooding, restrained small berry flavours and a generous earthy green herb finish.

19 **Ceppi Storici Barbera d'Asti** C £23.95  
A magnificent, youthful red with bright cherry and raspberry fruit and a supple, concentrated finish.

### Spain

20 **Edulis Rioja Tinto** B £19.95  
175ml £5.35 250ml £6.95  
100% Tempranillo with youthful, vibrant fruit that shows all the smokey damson qualities everyone enjoys.

### Portugal

21 **Dao Reserva Alianca** C £21.95  
Stonking good value, and you thought they only did Port!  
Rich, juicy, hedgerow fruit with elegant structure, delicious.

### South Africa

22 **Van Zijl 'Coffee' Pinotage** D £21.95  
Typically South African, robust and rustic.  
Aged in bottle which gives a hint of roasted coffee on the nose.

### Chile and Argentina

23 **Los Pastos Merlot** C £17.95  
175ml £4.95 250ml £6.25  
A textbook Merlot from Chile.  
Plums and damsons with real structure.

24 **Kaleu Malbec** D £18.95  
175ml £5.15 250ml £6.50  
Buckets of rich red smoky, spicy fruit from the foothills of Mendoza.

25 **Los Haroldos Oak Cask Malbec** C £25.95  
Once tried, you'll be hooked with this delicious Malbec.  
Dark and concentrated, heavy on the black cherries, with a warming winter spice finish.

26 **Santa Alba Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon** D £21.95  
In our estimation a much maligned variety. The quality of fruit and the resultant wine is truly magnificent.

### New Zealand and Australia

27 **Soldiers Block Shiraz** D £21.95  
Fresh, ripe berry fruit mingle with light spice and minty eucalyptus flavours. Smooth & full on the palate.

### USA

28 **The Big Top Zinfandel** D £22.95  
Rich, concentrated raspberries and redcurrants, with a hint of stewed sweetness to finish.
