

## White Wines

### France

- 1 **Domaine Vedilhan Viognier** 2 £20.95  
The style of this wine is dry, crisp and elegant, with fresh gooseberry fruit dominating the senses.

- 2 **Touraine Sauvignon Pre Baron** 1 £28.50  
A region in the Loire Valley that produces Sauvignon Blanc with all the aromatic and mineral qualities of much higher priced Sancerre's, but with a juicier style.

- 3 **Chablis A.C. Domaine de la Motte** 2 £34.50  
Typical of what a decent Chablis should taste like, not a trace of oak, pungent and flinty on the nose with a tad of creamy fruit beneath.

- 4 **Picpoul de Pinet** 3 £25.75  
If you like crisp, dry whites with vibrant acidity, then this is for you. Ideal fish and chicken wine but also a fantastic aperitif.

### Italy

- 5 **Cortefresca Pinot Grigio** 2 £19.95  
175ml £5.35 250ml £6.95  
An elegant, soft and dry white wine with excellent flinty minerals

- 6 **Gavi La Luciana** 2 £26.50  
Is fragrant and eloquent aromas reveal a lively, complex bouquet of floral notes and ripe fruit

### Spain

- 7 **Rioja Blanco Manzanos** 1 £21.95  
Bright and vibrant with mouthwatering fruit flavours. Soft aromatics and lithe acidity make a great alternative to the myriad of Sauvignon Blanc.

### Australia

- 8 **The Gavel Chardonnay** 2 £17.95  
175ml £4.95 250ml £5.75  
Modern Chardonnay is rapidly gaining popularity, with juicy, tropical fruit and soft, creamy acidity & definitely NO oak.

### South Africa

- 9 **False Bay Chenin Blanc** 3 £21.95  
Probably the best Chenin we've tasted from South Africa. Bursting with red apple fruitiness and a lithe limey finish.

### Chile

- 10 **Los Pastos Sauvignon Blanc** 2 £18.95  
175ml £5.15 250ml £6.25

Ripe apple and floral aromatics with typical sauvignon acidity.

*It's definitely upsetting a few Kiwi's!*

### New Zealand

- 11 **Aotearoa Sauvignon Blanc** 2 £23.50  
Fresh tropical fruit and gooseberry aromas as well as nuances of elderflower and nettle. Classic Marlborough!!

### Argentina

- 12 **Para Dos Torrontes** 5 £19.95  
A medium, fruity wine with flavours of gooseberry, green melon, white peach and grapefruit

## Red Wines

### France

- 14 **Beaujolais Villages** B £23.95  
Bursting with ripe, juicy raspberry and cherry fruit flavours. Light bodied, beautifully balanced and truly scrumptious. A premier league Beaujolais Villages!!

- 15 **Chateau Bellevue Cotes de Bourg** C £31.50  
Bordeaux value at its best. Blackcurrant's, supple tannins, cigar boxes & cedar wood.

- 16 **Cotes du Rhone Villages Les Coteaux** C £24.95  
Quite simply a great Rhone red. Dark fruit, soft spice and a hint of herbal leafiness.

- 21 **Mont Rocher Carignan Vin de Pays D'Oc** B £19.95  
With an abundance of intense red berry fruit and hints of vanilla flavours, this is soft and full flavoured with a smooth easy drinking style

- 17 **Pinot Noir Le Fou** C £23.95  
A delicious Pinot from the Languedoc. Subtle, vegetal nose with cherry/raspberry fruit.

### Italy

- 18 **Torridoro Primitivo di Manduria** E £32.95  
Deep purple hue with a complex bouquet of spices and ripe fruit scents. Powerful structure with a soft sweetness. Gentle tannins and a lasting finish. Fabulous with red meats.

- 19 **Ceppi Storici Barbera d'Asti** C £24.95  
A magnificent, youthful red with bright cherry and raspberry fruit and a supple, concentrated finish.

### Spain

- 20 **De Alto Rioja Tinto** B £20.95  
175ml £5.65 250ml £7.25  
100% Tempranillo with youthful, vibrant fruit that shows all the smokey damson qualities everyone enjoys.

- 28 **Bodegas Manzanos Crianze Rioja** C £26.50  
Aromatic and intense, lovely aromas of wild berries, blossom and nutmeg. Fresh, fruity and well balanced with sensations of raspberry, vanilla and cinnamon

### South Africa

- 22 **Van Zijl 'Coffee' Pinotage** D £21.95  
Typically South African, robust and rustic. Aged in bottle which gives a hint of roasted coffee on the nose.

### Chile & Argentina

- 23 **Los Pastos Merlot** C £18.95  
175ml £4.95 250ml £6.25

A textbook Merlot from Chile.

Plums and damsons with real structure

- 24 **Kaleu Malbec** C £19.95  
175ml £5.35 250ml £6.95

Buckets of rich red smoky, spicy fruit from the foothills of Mendoza.

- 25 **Los Haroldos Oak Cask Malbec** C £26.95  
Once tried, you'll be hooked with this delicious Malbec. Dark and concentrated, heavy on the black cherries, with a warming winter spice finish.

- 26 **Santa Alba Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon** D £21.95  
In our estimation a much maligned variety. The quality of fruit and the resultant wine is truly magnificent.

### New Zealand & Australia

- 27 **Telegraph Road Shiraz Viognier** D £18.95  
Fresh, ripe berry fruit mingle with light spice and minty eucalyptus flavours. Smooth & full on the palate.
